The Continental Development Framework: "The Africa We Want"

- The strategic blueprint for Africa's inclusive social and economic transformation over a period of 50 years.
- The African Union Agenda 2063 is based on 7 key Aspirations and 20 Development Goals aimed at building a prosperous, integrated, and secure continent, driven by its citizens (particularly youth and women), to become an influential global partner.
- The fifty-year strategic vision has been divided into five Ten-Year Implementation Plans to ensure flexibility and continuous evaluation.

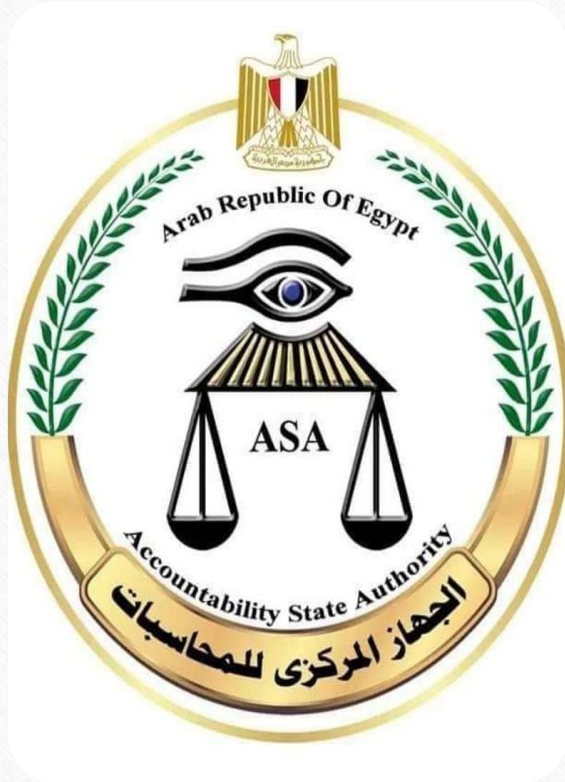
Egypt Vision 2030 for Sustainable Development within the African and International Framework

Egypt Vision 2030 represents an integrated development framework aimed at building a more inclusive and sustainable future. It is aligned with global and continental agendas, particularly the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and the Development Goals and the priorities of Africa Agenda 2063, thereby enhancing the integration of development efforts at various levels.

First: The National Role of the Accountability State Authority in Supporting the Implementation of Africa Agenda 2063



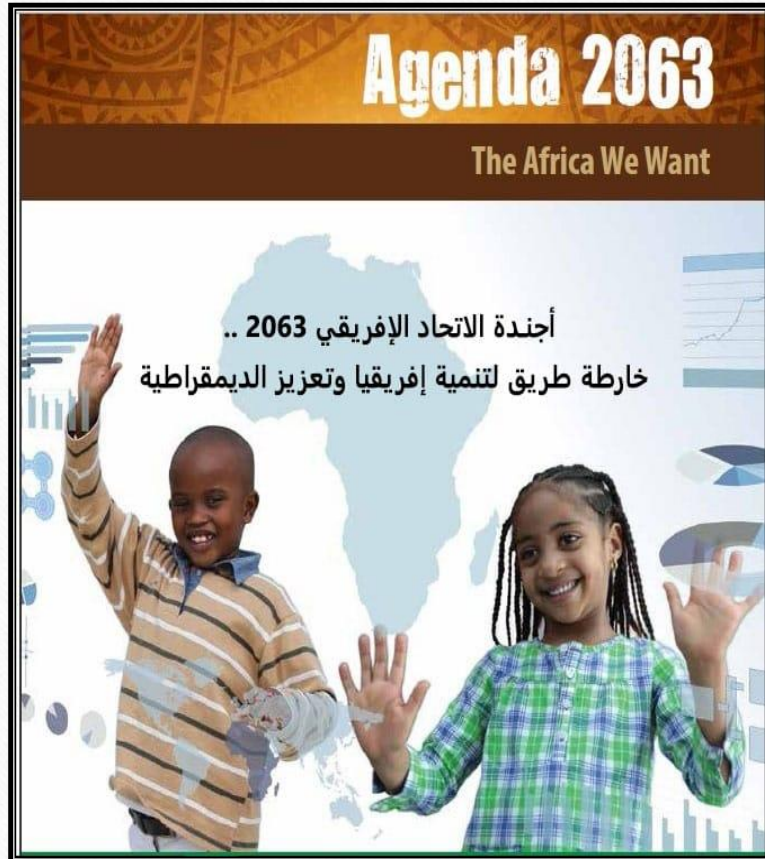
Auditing the Implementation of Egypt Vision 2030

- The implementation of Egypt Vision 2030 as a national strategy linked to the Sustainable Development Goals and Africa Agenda 2063.
- Conducting various types of audit: Performance Audit, Financial Audit, and Compliance Audit.
- Evaluating the efficiency of public resources utilization and monitoring the progress achieved.
- Monitoring actual results against approved targets and indicators.

ASA as a Key Partner in National Development

- Conducting comprehensive state-level oversight and up on the implementation of recommendations.
- Auditing the First National Strategic Goal: Improving the of the Citizen' s Life through auditing SDGs 1 and 2 (No Poverty and Zero Hunger).
- Auditing the Second National Strategic Goal: Social Equality through auditing SDG 5 (Gender Equality).
- Contributing to the development of entities' plans and operational programs based on audit observations.

Second: the Regional Role of the Accountability State Authority in Supporting the Success of Africa Agenda 2063



1. Auditing and Governance of the Accounts of the African Union and Some of Its Affiliated Entities:

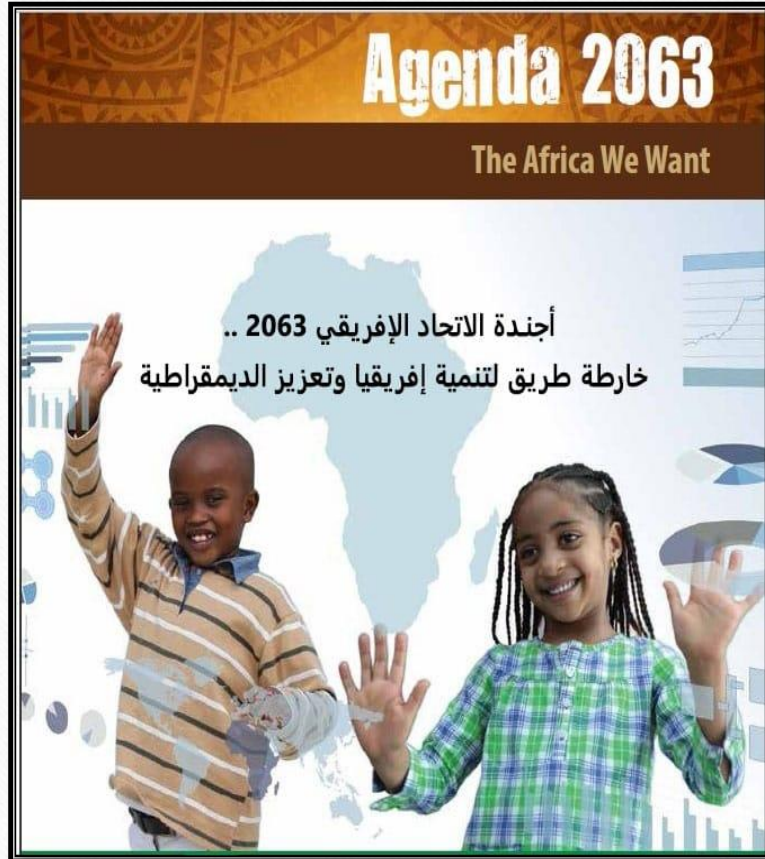
Examples include:

- ASA's leadership of Financial, Compliance, Performance, and IT Audit activities in its capacity as Chair of the African Union Board of External Auditors (2023–2024).
- Conducting inclusive and special audits of the accounts of the African Union Commission and most of its Affiliated Organs such as the Africa Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (Africa CDC), (AUDA-NEPAD). ECOSOCC, Pan-African Parliament, etc.

This contribution is linked to Aspiration 3: An Africa of Good Governance, Democracy, Respect for Human Rights, Justice and the Rule of Law.

Goal 12: Strong Institutions.

Goal 3: Healthy and Well-Nourished Citizens.



2. Capacity Building and Transfer of Leadership Expertise:

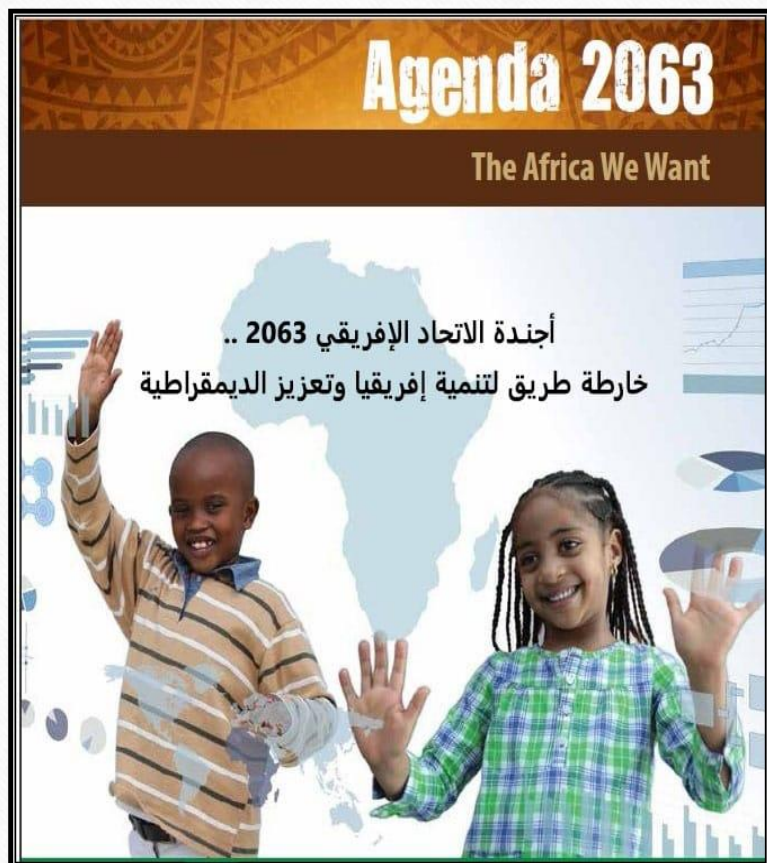
- Organizing an intensive training program in April 2026 for a high-level audit delegation from the Kingdom of Eswatini, entitled: "Audit Consequence Management Benchmarking Exercise".

This contribution is linked to the Agenda's aspirations related to strengthening the efficiency of public institutions in Africa, knowledge transfer, and continental capacity building.

3. Climate Governance and Continental Water Security:

Auditing and monitoring the operational budgets of the "Centre of Excellence for Climate Change Adaptation" that was hosted in Cairo.

This contribution is linked to Aspiration 1/Goal 7 related to environmental sustainability and climate resilience.



4. Governance of Energy Transition Projects:

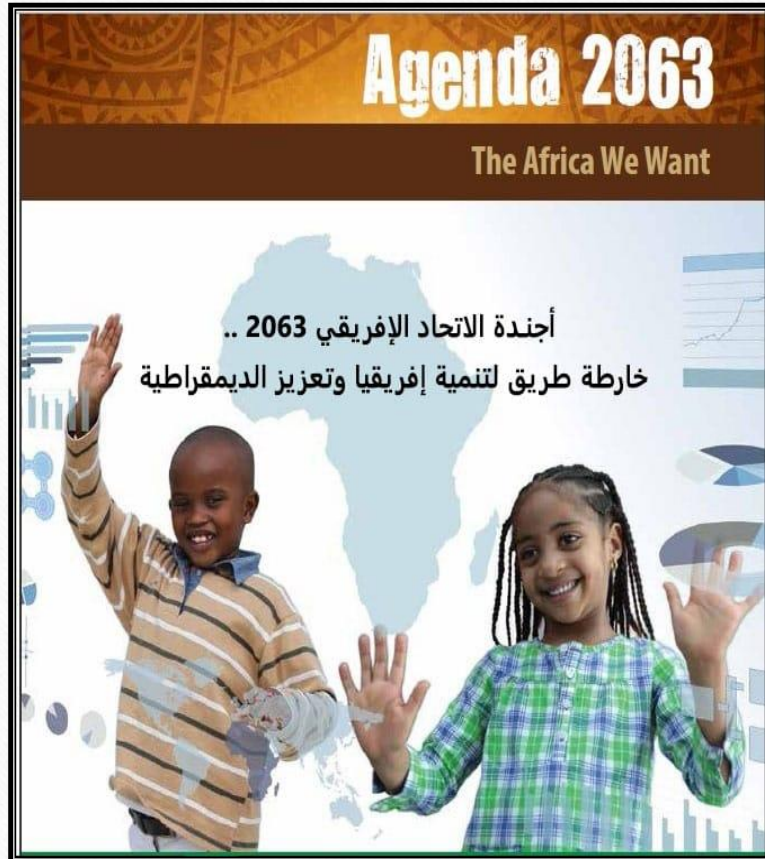
SAI Egypt focus on leading projects under the umbrella of INTOSAI to support the achievement of SDG 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy).

This contribution is linked to Aspiration 1: A Prosperous Africa.

5. Localization of the Agenda and Monitoring Progress:

The “NEPAD Footprint Report 2019” highlighted Egypt’s commitment to submitting its first national report on progress achieved during the first decade of Agenda 2063. This was intended to verify consistency between Egypt Vision 2030 and Africa Agenda 2063.

This contribution is linked to Aspiration 3/Goal 12, related to strengthening accountability and ensuring systematic linkage between national and continental plans.



6. Combating Corruption and Securing Development Resources:

- Chairing the INTOSAI Working Group on Fighting against Corruption and Money Laundering, as well as integrating and implementing international and continental conventions aimed at preventing corruption.
- Presenting a practical vision regarding the causes of corruption in Africa and measures to contain it during the First African Anti-Corruption Forum in Sharm El-Sheikh held in 2019.

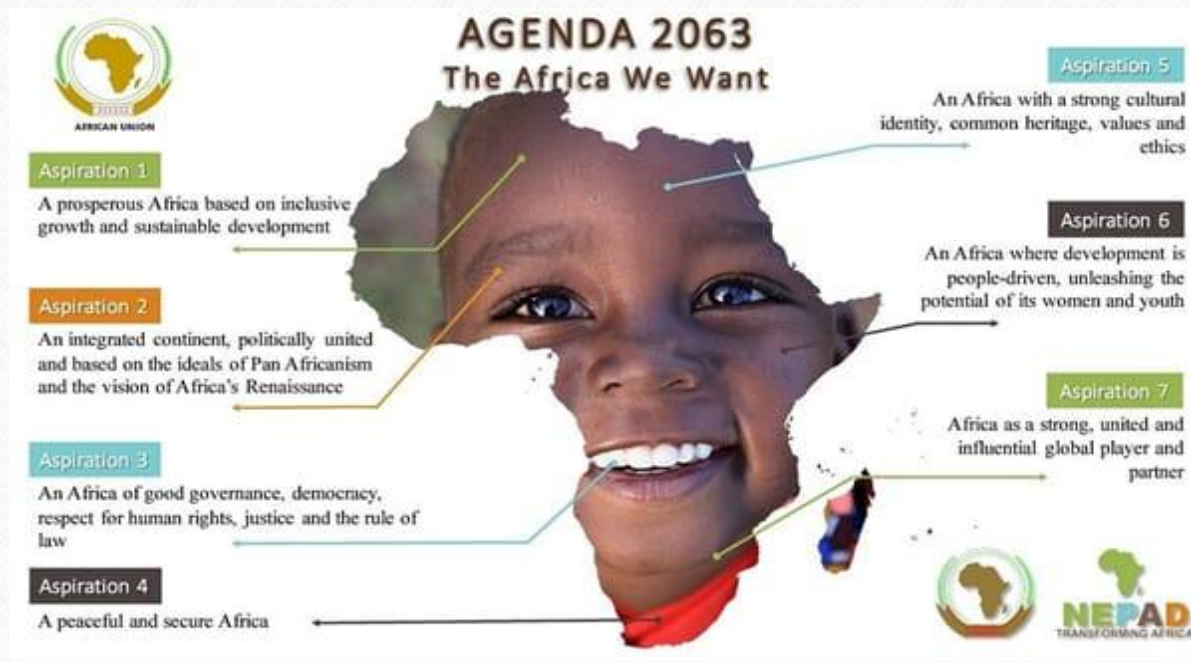
This contribution is linked to Goal 20 related to the self-financing of continental development.

7. Ma'at Initiative and Supporting Digital Audit Transformation:

ASA announced the "Ma'at Initiative " within XXV INCOSAI that was held in Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt in October 2025 as ASA assumed the chairmanship of INTOSAI. This Initiative aims to promote utilizing artificial intelligence in the audit work, supporting SAIs' digital transformation and bolstering proactive auditing.

This contribution is linked to Aspiration 1/Goal 2 related to the promotion of technology and digitalization to support successful development plans.

The success of Africa Agenda 2063 requires strong audit institutions capable of promoting: Accountability, Governance and Transparency. The Accountability State Authority of Egypt continues its role as a strategic partner in supporting the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals and realizing the vision :
